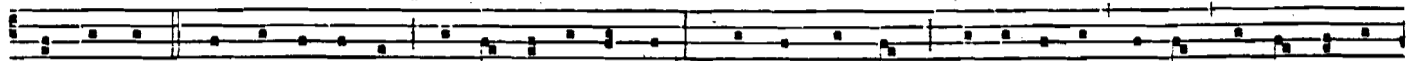
I BE-LIEVE in one God the Fa-ther Al-migh-ty, Ma-

to come. A-men.

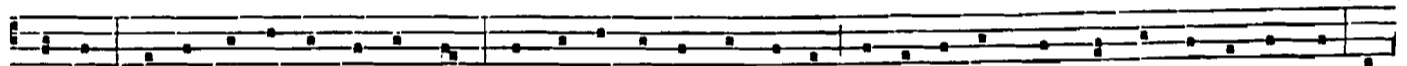
7. Let us pray. Ad-mon-ished by sa-ving pre-cepts, and guid-ed by div-ine in-sti-tu-tion, we make bold to say:

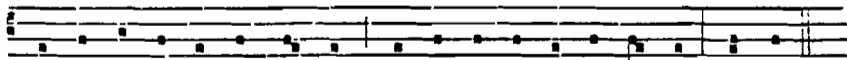
THE LORD'S PRAYER

hea-ven. Give us this day our dai-ly bread. And for-give us our tres-pass-es, As we for-give those that tres-pass a-against us. And

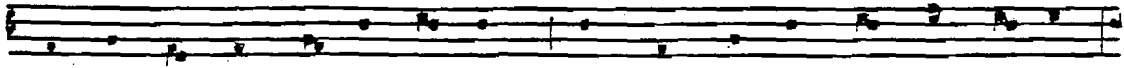


lead us not in-to temp-ta-tion; But de-li-ver us from e-vil: A-men.

in Christmastide, and Feasts of the Blessed Virgin and the Holy Name:

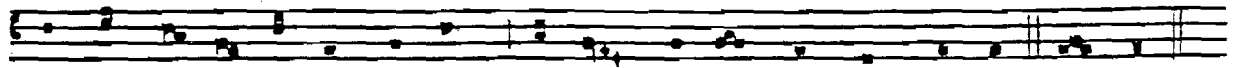
7b. All hon - our, laud, and glo - ry be, O Je - sus, Vir - gin - born, to Thee;
